CARDIFF AND VALLEYS RAILWAYS (TRANSFER) ORDER

APPLICANT'S PROPOSALS FOR FUNDING

On 4 June 2018, the Welsh Ministers awarded the applicant for the Order, Keolis Amey Wales Cymru Limited, a 15 year contract to operate and develop the Wales and Borders rail service and South Wales Metro, working in partnership with Transport for Wales. The contract provides for £1.9 billion to be invested in improving rail passengers' travel experience. The Order will help to facilitate these improvement by enabling the transfer of the core valley lines from Network Rail Infrastructure Limited to Transport for Wales.

The cost of implementing the transfer of the core valley lines will be met through a mixture of Welsh Government and UK Government funding.

The Order does not authorise any specific works that require to be funded separately.
